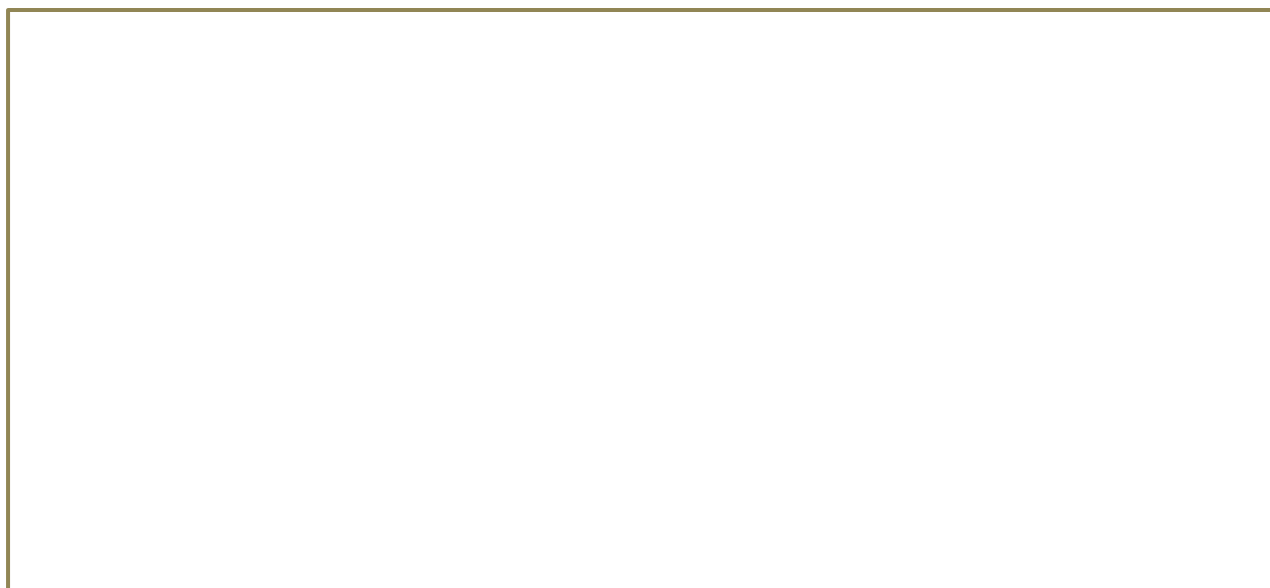

Ask your parents to help you play these fun games

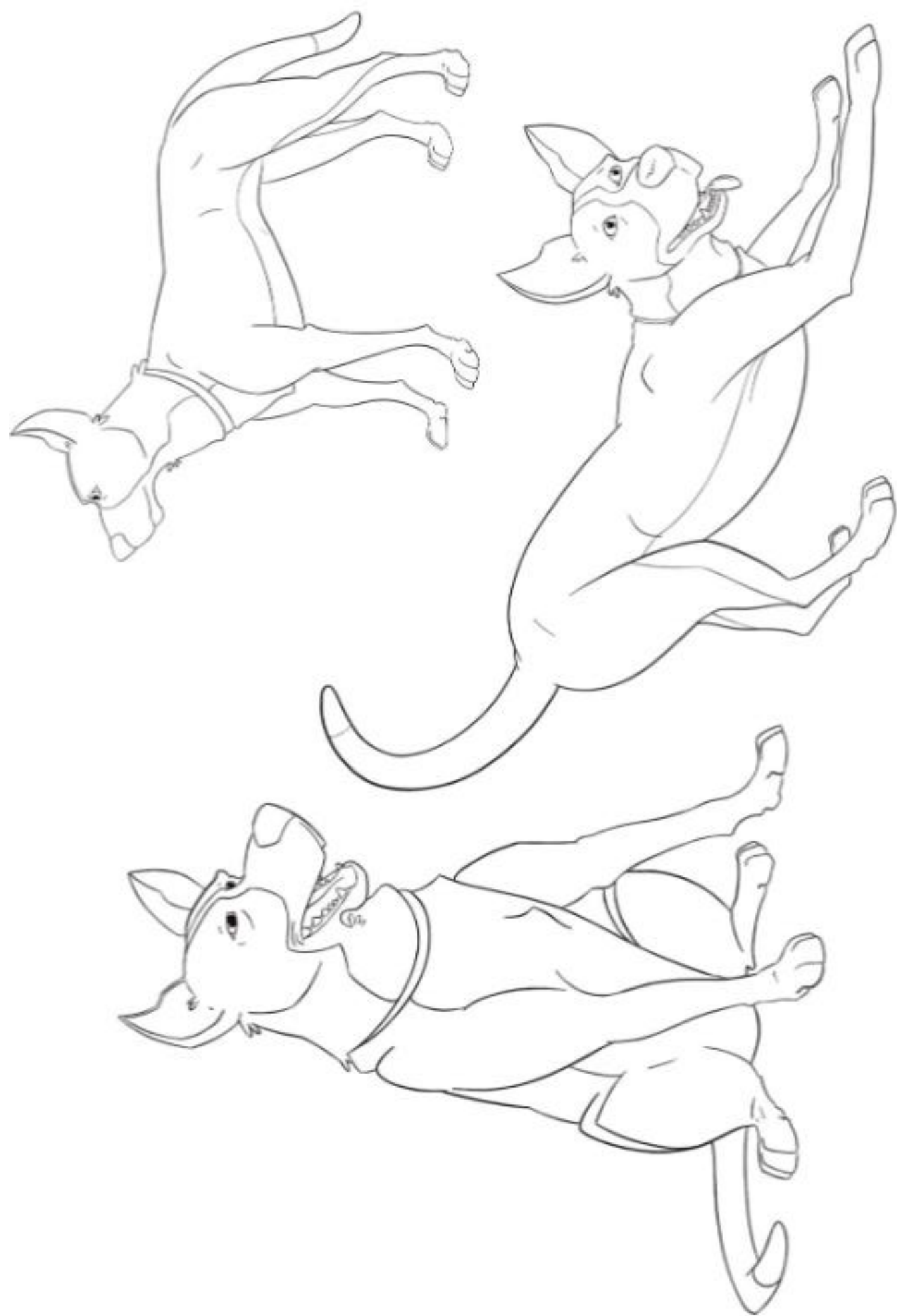
Obedience Class

This game is like Simon Says except we are going to pretend to be dogs. Ask a parent to be the trainer and call out actions for you to do but make sure that the adult says ‘the Trainer says’ before you do the action or else you will be out of the game! Here are some examples of commands the trainer can say:

- Sit
- Lay Down
- Beg
- Jump
- Speak (Woof)
- Roll Over
- Wag Your Tail
- Shake

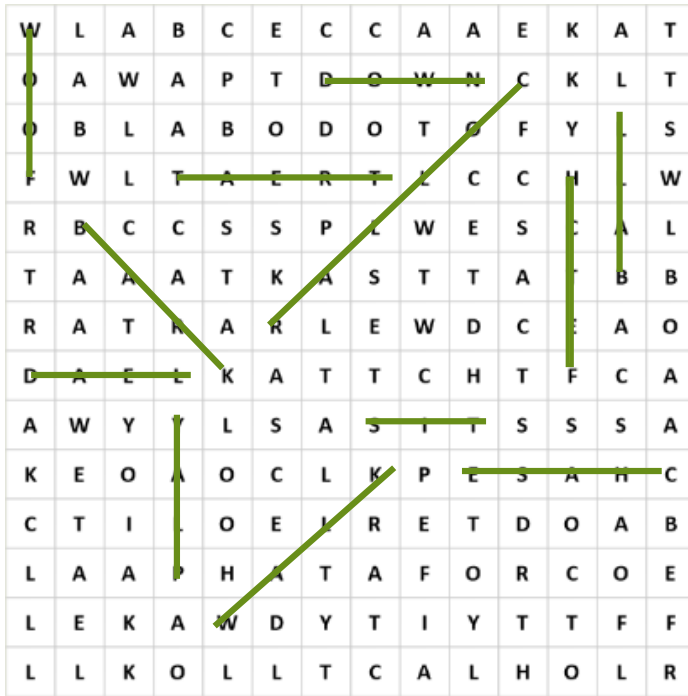
Doggy Doggy, Where’s Your Bone?

Sit in a semicircle around one chair facing away from the rest of the group. Place a bone or toy under the chair. The child pretending to be the dog sits in the chair. One child is picked to go steal the bone from under the chair and hides it behind their back. All the other children sit with their hands behind their backs and calls out ‘Doggy, doggy where’s your bone? Someone stole it from your home’ The ‘dog’ turns around and has to guess which child stole their bone.

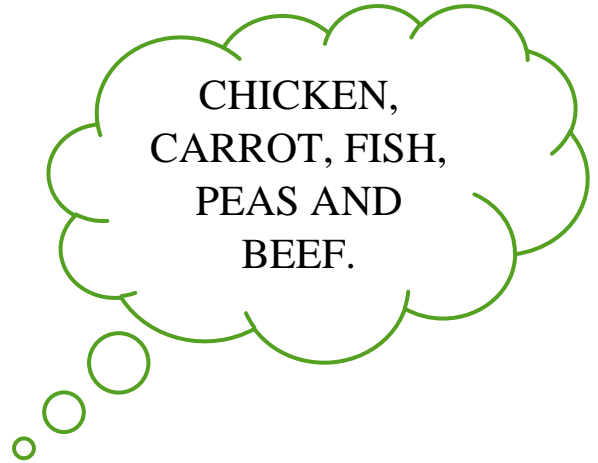
